The last round of 12 boards will be played today morning.

The Pairs Tournament also started yesterday evening. There will be 2 elimination rounds of 2 sessions each. Each session will be of 22 boards.

In the first elimination, 173 pairs are playing in 6 sections. There are 14 tables each in Sections "A", "B" & "C"; whereas "D", "F" has 15 Tables and "E" has fourteen & half tables. 17 TOP NS & 17 TOP EW pairs from combined sections "A", "B" & "C" and 18 TOP NS & 18 TOP EW from combined sections "D", "E" & "F" would qualify for the 2<sup>nd</sup> elimination round. These 70 pairs will be joined by the losing quarter-finalists in the 2<sup>nd</sup> elimination.

The first session of the Elimination – 1 is already over yesterday evening and the second session will continue today morning. We look forward to some more scintillating play from the participants in Quarter Final as well as Pair event.
